Opportunity to Win \$500 and Showcase Creative Ideas

The **Mini Pitch** provides students with an exciting opportunity to present their ideas – whether they are a solo innovator or part of a team – without the pressure of a formal business plan. This virtual competition allows students to submit a short video of up to 3 minutes explaining their idea, business concept, or product for a chance to win a \$500 prize. How to Participate:

Eligibility:

High school and college students in the Upper Peninsula are encouraged to participate, either individually or as part of a group.

Submission Details:

- Video Length: Up to 3 minutes
- Content: Briefly explain your idea, product, or business concept. No
 established business or formal business plan is needed. Judges are looking for
 creativity and originality.
- Deadline: Submit your video by January 16th, 2024

All submitted videos will be reviewed, and 8 selected finalists will be invited to the **Mini Pitch Reception** on **Thursday, January 30th**, where the selected video submissions will be viewed and winners will be announced.
